My name is Sister Jackie and I am part of a team of Sisters of St. Joseph from USA, India, and Brazil who run a hostel for teenage girls, most of who come from very impoverished families and villages. We have 44 girls at present, with capacity for 60.

This is a sponsored ministry of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Chambery, an international congregation serving in 18 countries. (We were able to get 60 packets to this location.)
